Rules and Regulations

Section 1: No person, except the properly authorized employees of the Angola Water Department will be permitted to tap or make and connections with the mains or distributing pipes of the water works or turn service connections on or off.

Section 2: No person shall be permitted to furnish other tenants with water or water connections. If more than one tenant is in the same building, a separate meter for each must be installed. Application for same must be made to the Village Clerk.

Section 3: All water bills must be paid by the last day of the month following date of issue. To all persons not complying with this rule, the Water Department reserves the right to shut off such service after 2 (two) bills remain unpaid, and that a charge of \$50.00 will be added to the arrears. **NOTE:** All back water rent and service charges must be paid before said service will be turned on.

Section 4: Meters must be placed in an accessible place and protected from freezing. Meter's damaged by frost will be charged to party who made application. Should meter be damaged by frost or frozen up it must be reported to the Village Clerk at once. In no case will anyone be allowed to disconnect or tamper with meter.

Section 5: All water pipes must be placed at least three and one-half (3 1/2) feet deep to prevent freezing. All pipes from service up to meter must be tested out by the Water Department and approved before said pipe is covered up. All necessary repairs on service connections will be provided by the Water Department and charged to the consumer. Leaks up to meter must be reported at once to the Superintendent.
