At Special meeting of the Village of Angola Board of Trustees held at Village Hall, 41 Commercial Street and via zoom in Angola, New York, County of Erie on Wednesday, May 25, 2022 at 5:30PM, there were;

PRESENT: Mayor Thomas Whelan, Trustees Jason Renaldo, Valerie Stonitsch and John Dybowski and Nicole Milks- Clerk Treasurer.

The Mayor made a Dedication of this meeting to the victims and their families of Buffalo, City of Good Neighbors who have been affected by the racist hate crime on Saturday, May 14, 2022.and to Buffalo and the children and teachers of Robb Elementary School in Uvalde, Texas- 21 innocent people were killed on Tuesday, May 24, 2022.

The Mayor added he would like to see Universal background checks be done on anyone who owns or wants to own a fire arm.

The Mayor will be at the fire station 2 at 9am on memorial day for the fire company inspection. All are welcome to attend.

Resolutions offered on May 25, 2022

#1 AUTHORIZE TEMPORARY USE PERMIT

RESOLVED that the Village of Angola Board of Trustees hereby approves the TEMPORARY USE PERMIT from the following:

1. Azalia Garlow- Peaceful Soul Farmers Market on Tuesdays from June 28 – August 30, 2022. A Farmers Market on Main Street in the Business District, vendor and farmers will vary weekly. Main Street Closed from Kim’s Shear Expressions to Center Street from 7:30AM- 2:00PM.

Trustee Dybowski asked if Azalia would close Center Street from Main Street to First Street to the municipal lot. Azalia would not like to use Frist Street or the K & L Lot due to the grassy area would turn muddy on rainy days and it is too small of a space. Her other farmers market would hold 40 vendors she has already shrunk it down to 12-14 vendors.

Trustee Stonitsch asked if the tents can face her building and keep Main Street open. Trustee Stonitsch also added she would like to see Main Street closed for her event.

Mayor would like to approve the permit as is. He read Trustee Wilson’s comments and Police Chief Greg Szcawowicz’s comments as they were not able to attend.

Azalia agreed to use Center Street and asked if the Village would help her advertise by supplying a banner or an a frame (sandwich board) of the market. Mayor Whelan will look into this and get back to her.

A Motion to Close Center Street from Main Street to First Street only made by Trustee Dybowski seconded by Trustee Renaldo, unanimously carried.
