Village of Angola Zoning Board of Appeals Meeting
41 Commercial St, Angola, NY 14006
Wednesday, March 9, 2022 6:00 P.M

Call Meeting to Order:

1. Scott and Heather Ziobro, 64 Railroad Ave, Angola, NY 14006 to build a 40' x 30' pole barn style garage at the above address SBL# 251.07-4-7 in violation of the Village of Angola Zoning Law section 245, subsection 17, paragraph B.

Code allows for 16' in Height

Code states Not to exceed 900 Sq. Ft.

Mr. Ziobro stated the building will be 18' high, the shed on his property will be moved and the new building will be placed more than 10' away from the house.

A motion was made to allow a 40'x30' pole barn style at 64 Railroad Ave and allow the building to off set the rear left corner 46'. A motion was made by Jonica DiMartino and seconded by Brad LoGalbo, unanimously carried.

2. Reid Petroleum Corp, 141 North Main St, Angola, NY 14006 to construct a sign at the above address SBL# 235.16-2-31 in violation with the Village of Angola Zoning Law section 245, subsection 11, paragraph B exceeding 60 Sq. Ft.

The North and South end of the proposed canopy sign do not meet current conditions, Asking for 68.75 Sq.Ft.

A motion to allow a 68.75 Sq Ft sign to be installed at (Crosby's) Reid Petroleum Corp- 141 North Main Street made by Todd Dybdahl and seconded by Jonica DiMartino, unanimously carried.

Planning Board

1. Review Bait Shop Sign- Andrew Mulvihill and Jacob Grassmick- owners of Blizzard Bait and Tackle LLC explained the sign will be a similar composite construction and similar size as Dawn's Restaurant. The sign will stick out so both sides of Main Street drivers will see it. The owners also asked if a sign stating "Boat Parking" can be installed and parking spots can be in the municipal lot. Owners also would like the tree trimmed in front of building before installing the sign.

A motion was made to request a boat parking sign made by Jonica DiMarino and seconded by Dan Klauk

2. Garbage out prior to garbage day throughout the Village- Planning Board members discussed there has been garbage throughout the Village in the streets or items that Modern disposal is unable to clean up and left out after garbage day. They

will discuss with DPW to see if they can clean up. The Village Clerk will have an add published regarding garbage day and other recycling events throughout the year.

- 3. Review Parking Code- example: Resident on High Street parks over the sidewalk**

Planning Board will review the parking code and look into no parking on the Village right away and no parking in front yards.

The Board asks the Code Enforcement Officer, Phil Tremblay to attend the April meeting.
