Regular Board Meeting
Monday, September 13, 2021 6:00 P.M

At Regular meeting of the Village of Angola Board of Trustees held at Village Hall, 41 Commercial Street in Angola, New York, County of Erie on Monday, September 13, 2021 at 6:00PM, there were;

PRESENT: Mayor Thomas Whelan, Deputy Mayor Jason Renaldo, Trustees John Wilson, Valerie Stonitsch and John Dybowski and Nicole Milks- Clerk Treasurer, John Grennell - Village Attorney, Jack Krajacic - Crew Chief, Donald Gallo – Village Engineer, Greg Szarowicz - Police Chief

Dedication of the meeting was made in honor of Howard “Hub” Frawley followed by a moment of silence and the PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

VISITORS: Rob Fitzpatrick of 8798 Lake Shore spoke and explained he will be opening a barber shop called Lake Shore Grooming lounge in the Village to open 11/1. The location will be at 11 N Main Street, next door to BTR Brews.

New Business:

- 1. New Angola Theater Closing-** Listed For Sale \$200,000
- 2. ARPA Covid Stimulus Money-** \$107,743.27- First half received. Project Ideas needed. Mayor Whelan explained the money could be used for Waterline projects on Lake Shore Road and Trustee Stonitsch mentioned installing new water meters.
- 3. Name for K&L Lot-** require permit for use next year and install electric. The Crew chief suggested to contact National Grid to get power from electric pole. Trustee Wilson requested a breaker to be installed. Trustee Stonitsch suggested to name the park K & L Corner.
- 4. Annual Newsletter-** the Mayor explained the newsletter will be out in November of each year.
- 5. Memorials-** Benches and Proclamation and bricks – Mayor explained he received a letter requesting a memorial in honor of Past Mayor Carlson. Trustee Dybowski asked what constitutes a memorial? Mayor Whelan noted that was a good question and would like the Village Board to think about it.

Visitors: Brian Farrell of 612 Fulton introduced himself as the President of Lake Bay Homeowner Association, Mark Zeis of 608 Sandy as Vice President of Lake Bay Homeowner Association They handed out their newsletter. The Associations is interested in installing a fire hydrant in their community. Trustee Wilson suggested having the Village Engineer review. Jack Krajacic is aware of the lack of hydrants in the area. Don Gallo arrived later in the evening and will meet with the Crew Chief and look into possibly adding a hydrant and further details.

REPORTS

Code Enforcement- Excused

Trustee Dybowski reported he sent a letter to the town requesting maintenance logs for hydrants. He is also working on creating a map that indicates when waterlines were installed.

Trustee Stonitsch reported the library harvest dinner is coming up and tickets are available for anyone who is interested in attending, there will be a new business opening called Lake Shore Grooming lounge, and a Juicery will also be opening soon who will include a farmers market, there is a Rediscover Angola meeting next Monday, ribbon cutting at Doggo Mafia, Fall Fest on 9/18. She also attended the Planning Board meeting on 9/8, and indicated everyone received a hand written report from member Brad LoGalbo.

Trustee Wilson reported the Fall Fest is Saturday and there will be a bike rodeo, chief counsel meeting fire dept, school is donating a sign to the fire department at Beach Rd entrance, fire contract negotiations

Trustee Renaldo reported he attended the NEST meeting at Chestnut Ridge, Cindy @ SunKing has been contacted regarding an electronic waste event. He will organize for late Spring in May or June, he also has been in contact with local artists for 15 N Main mural.

Mayor Whelan reported he watched the 9.11 remembrance flag assemblage on Center and Main and received many compliments.

Crew Chief reported he is getting radio read quotes, the DPW worked on 4 sink holes, and would like the Village to purchase the John Deere backhoe as indicated in resolution.

Fire Chief- (liaison) reported 38 calls, 7 fire related and 2 actuals, trained all month with new trainees. The fire department was awarded the FEMA grant which will replace 18 Scott packs.

Police Chief reported the police department is looking forward to the Bike Rodeo, Train tracks closed for 1 week and will share on Facebook.

Attorney reported he is working on the Hogg Waterline Easement; he is also working with code enforcement abandoned sign law. They both agree no changes should be made and to follow the State Law.

Clerk Treasurer reported the water loss report looks better this month, she has worked with the engineer on the waterline projects, and the Planning Board Survey is on Facebook.

#5 AUTHORIZE PURCHASE OF FIRE HYDRANT

WHEREAS, the Angola Fire Department has requested a hydrant to be purchased and installed near Fire Station 2, 150 South Main Street, and

RESOLVED, that the Angola Village Board hereby authorizes the purchase of the Fire Hydrant from Lock City of 650 West Ave, Lockport, NY not to exceed the \$5300 estimate and that the Department of Public Works will install said hydrant.

Discussion: Crew Chief advised \$2300 in parts to install hydrant. Trustee Dybowski asked if it will be metered, Crew chief said it will not. Trustee Dybowski asked How will it impact the South Main waterline? Crew Chief does not believe it will have any impact.

#6 ACCEPT APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT IN THE VILLAGE OF ANGOLA RETIAL WATER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, said project will extend potable water service and fire protection to a proposed house on the north side of Cradle Ave, and

Discussion: Trustee Wilson asked if there is a cost to the Village for the project, the Clerk advised Hogg is paying for the engineer and they are installing the waterline.

#8 AUTHORIZE PURCHASE AND BONDING OF JOHN DEERE BACKHOE LOADER

WHEREAS, the Village of Angola has received a purchase agreement from Five Star Equipment, 284 Ellicott Road, West Falls, NY for a 2022 Deere Backhoe Loader in the amount of \$79,256.89, and

WHEREAS, the balance due includes a trade in for the amount of \$25,000.00 for the current backhoe owned by the Village of Angola, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Village of Angola Board of Trustees hereby approves the purchase of the 2022 Deere Backhoe Loader

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, funds for the purchase of the backhoe shall be paid for by the issuance of a five (5) year bond to be sold to cover this backhoe and other needs to be covered by new bond funds.

Discussion: The Mayor asked who the current backhoe will be sold to. Crew Chief will sell the current backhoe to the school.

Trustee Wilson made a motion to accept the audit of the bills, seconded by Mayor Whelan- roll call vote was made all said AYE
