At Regular meeting of the Village of Angola Board of Trustees held at Village Hall, 41 Commercial Street in Angola, New York, County of Erie on Monday, January 9, 2023 at 6:00PM, there were;

Trustee Dybowski- reported there is a water loss of 32% this past billing. 5% of the loss was due to putting out the fire at 22 South Main Street.
