Mayor Whelan explained that 42 North Main will be renovated and restored to long term apartment rentals with the first floor being an overnight rental where you can book the rentals through AirBnB or another website. The clerk will provide the Village Board with all of the details of the application. Mayor Whelan explained 72 North Main Street will be restored and renovated into a theater as it originally looked.
