Regular Board Meeting
Monday, February 28 2022 6:00 P.M

At Regular meeting of the Village of Angola Board of Trustees held at Village Hall, 41 Commercial Street and via zoom in Angola, New York, County of Erie on Monday, March 14, 2022 at 6:00PM, there were;

PRESENT: Mayor Thomas Whelan, Deputy Mayor Jason Renaldo, Trustees John Wilson, Valerie Stonitsch and John Dybowski and Nicole Milks- Clerk Treasurer, John Grennell - Village Attorney, and Crew Chief Jack Krajacic,

The Mayor Called the meeting to order and dedicated to the people of Ukraine.

Resolutions Offered on Monday, February 28, 2022

#1 APPROVE PURCHASE OF OUTDOOR GARBAGE CANS

WHEREAS, the Village of Angola Parks is in need of replacement garbage cans, and **WHEREAS**, the Village Clerk has received 3 quotes, from Tree Top Products, Parkitects and Playground Equipment, and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Angola Board of Trustees hereby approves the purchase of up to six (6) 32-gallon outdoor garbage cans at a cost of \$598.85 per can plus shipping from Tree Top Products.

Mayor Whelan explained the cans will be placed at Herman Park, K&L Lot and Gazebo Crew Chief confirmed he will pour cement pads and anchor them in.

A Motion was made by Trustee Wilson and seconded by Trustee Stonitsch, A Roll Call Vote was made, and all said aye.

#2 AUTHORIZE CLERK TO CONTACT NATIONAL GRID FOR AN ESTIMATE

BE IT RESOLVED, the Village of Angola Clerk Treasurer is hereby authorized to contact National Grid for an estimate of 4 light poles with outlets at 83 North Main (K&L Lot).

Trustee Wilson suggested to look into a LED lighting grant as well.

A Roll Call Vote was made, and all said aye.

Discussion: Lake Shore Waterline Extension of replacement per Donald Gallo Engineering Recommendation

Mayor explained he believes the Village should not extend the line any further as the cost will be more of a fiscal burden on the Village. He also explained the water leaks are closer to Lake Street and the extension will not impact that area.

Trustee Wilson explained this is a 110-year-old line. The town will have an added 22 taxpayers to the waterline. The water demand will increase as housing is going up in this area and there is a trailer park close by that could eventually tie into the Village line. Other projects that the Village will need to consider is purchasing a fire truck.

Trustee Stonitch verified the waterline was replaced in the area near the new development and asked if the Village will be replacing the new line again. Crew Chief Krajacic verified a small portion was replaced for the new development in the area and the new line will be connected to the replaced line.

Trustee Dybowski believes the village must do it as the Village needs the water department. There will not be a Village without the Village water.

#3 AWARD BID FOR THE LAKESHORE WATERLINE REPLACEMENT

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Angola received six (6) bids for the Lake Shore Waterline Replacement Project, and

WHEREAS, after full review of all bids at an advertised bid opening on February 9, 2022 at 10:00 AM, and upon recommendation of the Village Engineer, Donald Gallo,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Angola Board of Trustees hereby awards the lowest bid in the amount of \$588,328.00 from E & R General Construction Inc 38 St David's Drive, West Seneca, NY 14224; for the said Lake Shore Waterline Project as advised by the Village Engineer and contingent upon authorization of BONDS.

A roll call vote was made, Trustee Wilson, Trustee Renaldo, Trustee Stonitsch and Trustee Dybowksi- AYE

The following resolution was Tabled by Trustee Stonitsch and seconded Trustee Wilson

#4 ACCEPT RECOMMENDATION FROM ENGINEER DONALD GALLO

WHEREAS, the Village of Angola has received bids for the Lake Shore Waterline Project and the low bid has come in lower than anticipated, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Angola Board of Trustees have received a recommendation to adjust the unit and lump sum price quantities upward to extend the Lake Shore Waterline Project as far south of Cradle Avenue about 1000 feet and,

WHEREAS, the additional construction cost is approximately \$203,000.00 and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Village of Angola Board of Trustees accepts the recommendation to extend the Lake Shore Waterline Project.

Village Clerk explain the new Recycle bins will be delivered in the next few weeks as the new recycle program begin in April.

On March 1 the Village will help hold a ribbon cutting ceremony at Azalia's Juicery. The bait and tackle store is also opening.

A motion was made to ADJOURN to regular board meeting on Monday, March 14, 2022 at 6:00PM, with a 5:30 workshop made by Trustee Renaldo and seconded by Trustee Wilson, unanimously carried.
