At a regular meeting of the Village of Angola Board of Trustees held via Teleconference on Zoom per Executive Order 202.1 in Angola, New York, County of Erie on Wednesday, December 16, 2020 at 7:00PM, there were;

PRESENT: Mayor Howard Frawley, Deputy Mayor William Houston, Trustees John Omlor, John Wilson, Thomas Whelan and Nicole Milks- Clerk Treasurer, John Grennell- Village Attorney, Jack Krajacic- Crew Chief

#1 APPROVE TO HIRE DEPUTY CLERK

RESOLVED That the Village Board approves the appointment by Mayor Frawley to the Full-Time Deputy Clerk position of Hannah Dorosz of 13 Woodward Ave, Angola to begin on January 4, 2021.

She will have a 12-month probationary period and her salary will be \$31,200 annually (\$15.00 per hour)

#2 APPROVE TO HIRE WATER CLERK

RESOLVED That the Village Board approves the appointment by Mayor Frawley to the Part-Time Water Clerk position of Karen Dybowski to begin on January 4, 2021.

She will have a 12-month probationary period and her salary will be \$13.00 per hour with no benefits.

#3 APPROVE THE CREW CHIEF TO PURCHASE VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Angola directs the Village Clerk to contact Bond Counsel and Evans Bank for one Bond Anticipation Note for the purchase of DPW vehicles and,

WHEREAS, the Crew Chief has received quotes and proposals to replace the 2009 Ford Dump Truck and the 2011 International Dump Truck and,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board approves the Proposal # 15962-01 from Regional Int Corp for the purchase of a 2021 HV507 SFA in the amount not to exceed \$179,995.68 and

BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board approves the Quote # 30665 from Van Bontel for the purchase of a 2020 Ford F-450 in the amount not to exceed \$63,435.60 and

BE IT RESOLVED, once the new trucks arrive the old trucks will be declared surplus and sold.

A motion was made by Trustee Whelan, seconded by Trustee Houston

Attorney advised if prices change this resolution is not allowed

Roll Call was made and all were in favor said AYE

Mayor Frawley, Trustee Houston, Trustee Omlor, Trustee Wilson, Trustee Whelan

Trustee Houston reported the Village should reach out to the town regarding anticipating a new waterline on Lake Shore Rd near the bike path.

He also explained the Village could apply for a Bond to replace a waterline as the Village is no longer paying the bond on the original water plant bond from 1980, and the village will be done

paying on the refinanced bond from the water plant and also the bond from the Grove Street Waterline. The Village could take a new bond out to replace a waterline on Schwert Road to Lake Street on LakeShore Rd. This would cost about \$1,000,000.00 to replace. The Village is currently paying for waterleaks in this area and loss of water.

Motion to ADJOURN to regular meeting on January 12, 2021 at the Village Hall at 7:00PM was made by Trustee Whelan and seconded by Trustee Wilson
